MOSQUITO MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHERE DO MOSQUITOES REST?

Most adult mosquitoes rest in landscaping, trees and foliage around your property during the daytime. Heavy landscaping including ivy can provide ample harborage for thousands of mosquitoes. Female mosquitoes will typically rest under the bottom side of the leaves under protection before emerging in the evening and searching for their food meal. Unfortunately you and your family are the food meal.

WHEN ARE MOSQUITOES MOST ACTIVE?

Mosquitoes are most active in the warmer months of April thru September when you tend to use your backyard the most. Our Mosquito Management Program provides for a monthly routine service schedule during these warmer months when you need it most.

TREATMENT DETAILS

We will treat the landscaping, foliage and foundation around the property with a residual adulticide to reduce the population of mosquitoes in their resting sites. We also treat any mosquito breeding sites on the property with a larvicide to help prevent mosquito larvae from developing into adults. This program is a very effective way to take back control of your yard and enjoy it again.
